### Call for projects

#### **N° 1 - Basic research in cardiology (€ 15.000 single center - € 20.000 multicenter)**

The call concerns non-commercial projects for basic research in the field of cardiovascular pathology. This research encompasses scientific disciplines such as biochemistry, physiology, and pharmacology and their interplay, and involves laboratory studies with cell cultures, animal studies or physiological experiments. #### **N° 2 - Clinical research in cardiology (€ 15.000 single center - € 20.000 multicenter)**

The call concerns non-commercial projects for clinical research in the field of cardiovascular pathology. The research must be centred on the patients and aimed to determine the role of medication, intervention, diagnosis, symptoms or prevention in the physiological or pathological processes of the cardiovascular system. #### **N° 3 - Research in cardio-oncology (€ 15.000 single center - € 20.000 multicenter)**
